I AGREE in consideration for my participation in this Competition (Eddie MacMurdo Memorial Horse Show) to the following:

I AGREE that I choose to participate voluntarily in the Competition with my horse as a rider, driver, handler, lessee owner, agent, coach/trainer, or as parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor. I am fully aware and acknowledge that horse sports and the Competition involve inherent dangerous risks of accident, loss, and serious bodily injury including broken bones, head injuries, trauma, pain, suffering, or death ("Harm"). I AGREE to release Washington State Horsemen and the Competition from all claims for money damages or otherwise for any Harm to me or my horse and for any Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm caused by me or my horse to others, even if the Harm resulted, directly or indirectly, from the negligence of Washington State Horsemen or the Competition. I AGREE to expressly assume all risks of Harm to me or my horse, including Harm resulting from the negligence of Washington State Horsemen or the Competition. I AGREE to indemnify (that is, to pay any losses, damages, or costs incurred by) Washington State Horsemen and the Competition and to hold them harmless with respect to claims for Harm to me or my horse, and for claims made by others for any Harm caused by me or my horse at the Competition. I have read the Washington State Horsemen rules about protective equipment, and I understand that I am entitled to wear protective equipment without penalty, and I acknowledge that Washington State Horsemen strongly encourages me to do so while WARNING that protective equipment cannot guard against all injuries. If I am a parent or guardian of a junior exhibitor, I consent to the child's participation and AGREE to all of the above provisions and AGREE to assume all of the obligations of this release on the child's behalf. I AGREE that Washington State Horsemen and "Competition" as used above includes all of their officials, officers, directors, employees, agents, personnel, volunteers, and affiliated organizations. The construction or application of Washington State Horsemen rules is governed by the laws of the state of Washington.

IMPORTANT NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS:

- Signatures of all Owners/Agents, Drivers/Handlers/Riders (Non-Owner), Coaches/Managers/Trainers, and Parents/Guardians of Jr. Exhibitors are MANDATORY! Failure to sign this entry will constitute a fine of \$50 (per WSH). Exhibitor numbers will not be released until all parties have signed.
- Please include copies of your WSH Membership and WSH or USEF Amateur cards. There is a \$3 non-refundable fee charged to file an Affidavit attesting to your WSH membership and/or Amateur status if you are unable to present your cards at the show office.
- Entries for Breed classes cannot be accepted without a copy of your horse's registration papers.
- All fees are due and payable with this entry. Your entry cannot be processed without payment in full for all fees due with this entry form. A minimum of one class entry is required to pre-enter. Exhibitors who are pre-entered do not pay the Post Entry Fee to enter additional classes at the show. Entries not received by Entry Closing Date will be charged Post Entry Fees.
- Open checks are a courtesy for exhibitors who have already paid to enter the show who wish to run a tab for additional classes entered during the show. Missed or scratched classes will not be deducted from the amount owing. Exhibitors will be allowed to transfer entry fees from one class to another provided the trade is submitted to the show office on the appropriate form 3 classes prior to the first class being traded.
- Entries can not be accepted at the gate and must be made at least 5 classes prior to the class being entered.
- Riders sharing the same horse must each be entered in the show on a separate entry form. Exhibitor numbers are assigned to single horse & rider combinations.
- Due to insurance liability issues, exhibitors may not be on the grounds before Noon Friday, and only horses entering the show are permitted on the show grounds (an entry form must be signed and fees paid before horses can be exercised or stabled on the grounds); no exceptions.
